We praise the Lord for several boys getting saved in Watson Lake on our recent trip there, as well as our first outdoor service there which was attended by a couple of natives.

We found on our survey of these remote villages that there are certainly some big challenges and sizable obstacles to overcome. But God knows what they are and how to communicate the Gospel to these dear people.

Remember that in sending our family to the field, you have a team. Paul and Johnathan, our two oldest, are going to the communities of Iskut and Watson Lake to do summer evangelism work while the rest of us remain in Hyder and Stewart working on getting some

additional people involved in our services at home.
