Dear Supporters and Friends,

I pray this letter finds each of you doing well. We are all well at Fair Haven Home for Men, Inc. God has done so much since our last letter. We have received our tax exempt status with the IRS. This will help us in getting food to feed the men and with other areas that we can now get help. We are thankful to reach this land mark in this ministry.

We have been looking for a building to have a store to sell item that are donated, that we can generate more income for Fair Haven. I spoke with a business man in Moncks Corner about a building and he has agree to let us use the build for one year free rent. This is about \$6000 if we had to pay rent. The building needed some work and we were praying about how we would get the funds to pay for the remodeling of the building. Kevin Baker called me and said that he wanted to help Fair Haven and wanted to know if we had a project going on he could help with. I told him what we were doing and HE wrote us a check for \$3800 for the repair to the buidng which included a new shingle roof, painting inside and out and fixing some walls inside. Well that is not all. We needed things to sell. We were praying about what we would do in this situation. We had several people offer their things to sell but to open a store we needed a good many items to sell. A woman from Myrtle Beach area was closing her shop and had \$10,000 worth of merchandise that she would sell for \$2500. That is good if you have \$2500 and we did not have any money. So again we prayed and Friendship Baptist Church in Warburg, TN gave the money to buy the merchandises and did not even know of the need. I say our God is amazing. We now have a building we don't have to pay for, we have it repaired to look nice for those shopping with us, and we have lots of items to sell. If you would like to donate to the store please feel free to call me and we will come and get the items so we can sell them and put the money back in the home.

We had a man graduate from Fair Haven Phase two program. This means Patrick Vinson has been at Fair Haven for one year and three months. He is now doing well. He works a job, renting a house, paying his bills. He was saved within the first month he was with us. He is a very different man.

I get calls, letters, and e-mails weekly from people all over the US needing our help. The problem is that we can only take as many as we have beds to accommodate them. The need is great. I pray by the next prayer letter we will have our building underway. It will take a lot of work, time, effort and money to finish this building, but if one man gets help and gets going in the right direction it will be worth everything.

I just made a new video for the Home. I did some research and illegal prescription drug use has risen 500% in the past 21 years. That is a startling figure, but people in our day are in bondage to drugs. Deaths from Drug overdoses in past 20 years has risen 540%. We often live in our worlds and never see this side of society, but it is destroying people in our day. Where do these people get help? Who will take the time and effort to help them? Fair Haven Home for Men will.

We have several new men coming in the next few weeks. We pray they get the help and direction they need in their lives. Thank you so much for helping us in this great ministry of helping men. We are a help up not a hand out. God bless you each one.
