Prayer Letter Aug - Sept 2011

Sometimes it is hard for us to put into words our thankfulness. We are so thankful for how good God is to us and for Him putting people like you into our lives. Each one of your prayers, cards, letters, and the support of our ministry does not go unappreciated. Only in heaven will we fully know the impact we have made and have the words to express our true gratitude. Over the last couple months God has blessed us tremendously and we wanted to start this letter out with thanksgiving.

August started out with us celebrating our 21st wedding anniversary. We were thankful to be able to slip away from our busy schedules for a few days together and had a wonderful time. I am thankful to God for a wife who not only loves me but the ministry that God has called us to. Then we traveled to Florida for a couple great prison revivals. While in Florida not only were we in prison but we were also able to preach to a church youth group and at a Christian school. This was a blessed trip with 2 saved at the Hastings Youth Academy and 9 saved at the Hillsborough West Detention Center. One of the boys who were saved on this trip has been on the news lately. He had planned to bomb his school and had a goal to kill more kids than the Columbine school shootings. During a Saturday morning service he came forward and gave his heart to Christ. Each one of you had a part in this. To God be the glory!

September had us back in Walnut Grove, MS at the large juvenile prison there. While there we were not only able to visit the dorms but also several classrooms and attend a boot camp release ceremony. How my heart was stirred for each of these young men who were getting out and their families. My prayer was that each one of them may have given their hearts to Christ while locked up so that they would never have to come back. Statistics say that many will, but the scriptures say that God can make a difference. I hope they will choose the scriptures. We were able to reach 13 of them with the Gospel at this facility. Then each night we were able to go to the Leake county jail and 2 men were saved in these meetings.

On a personal note in September we experienced both a valley and victory as my dad was injured in a handgun accident. He had to be hospitalized twice and had some surgery to remove the bullet. Many of you helped me pray for him and I thank you for your prayers and calls of encouragement. The good news is that while there I was able to pray with him and he rededicated his heart to God. He had been out of church and God's will for a long time but now is praying, reading God's Word and looking forward to being able to go to church. As many of you know I have prayed for him for a long time and hated to see him get hurt, but was so glad to see him get his heart right with God. Please keep him in your prayers as he recuperates and my Mom as she takes care of him. Thanks again for all you do and may God bless you all for your kindness.
