Dear Friends,

Praise the Lord! Things are going very well in the prison. As we reported in our last letter we have now started a Spanish service. We are averaging 23 men per service. The men are excited and have the order of service ready when the Spanish preacher arrives. They practice special songs during the week to sing. All the preacher has to do is get up and preach and they are doing a good job of that. We have been able to get six preachers to help in the services. I have placed them on a rotation and they come in once every six weeks. There has been a couple of the Spanish men saved. Also I have, as of last Friday, been able to start a morning Pastoral Counseling class. There are some men in another program, a state sponsored program, which are forced to come and sit in my class to receive religious instruction which their program requires. These men are some who would not be in this class unless they were forced. So I am going to make the best of giving them the Word of God while I have the chance. There are thirteen of them so far and we expect a few more. In all we have thirty five men. The number will grow as the word gets out about the class. Only the men who are not working or in school are allowed to come. I am teaching on important areas of life. The first week I taught on what is a good man. Some of the men who are forced to come laughed at me while I taught. I taught such things as a good man marries one woman and has children only with her. That is a joke in this day. Many of these men have children with different women in different parts of the country. Fornication is a prevalent sin among these men. It is little wonder that they laughed at me. Any way I reported the disturbance and they won't be laughing anymore. Security will see to that. I do pray the Word of God will work in their heart and they will get saved. What a joy that would be. Pray for the other services we have weekly. I have a Sunday morning service at 8:00 AM. I am able to preach and then get back to my home service which is a blessing. We have a Monday night service and a Thursday night Bible study. This keeps us pretty busy but it is a real blessing. We know the Word of God is the only thing that can direct a man's life.

We want to thank you for all that you do in helping us stay supported so we can stay in the prison. The Lord Jesus Christ is a Saviour worth proclaiming. He is able to do all that He said He can do and we are witnesses of these things.
