TAYLOR FAMILY UPDATE FOR JANUARY 2011

It is with great joy we report to you again, as our recent revivals have gone very well. The two new prisons mentioned in our last letter were a great success. At the Vaiden, MS facility we were blessed with two hours for services, and four men walked the aisle during invitation wanting to be saved! In the Yazoo County facility, we saw a total of nine men saved during both visitation and services. These new facilities proved to be a blessing to us, and we look forward to returning soon.

We had a two revivals recently where no one was saved (one in AL and one in MS), but we were still able to spend several hours pass out tracks and witnessing and still able to preach in the evenings. Please pray for the many men that heard the gospel, that its power may convict their hearts. After all, it the gospel's power that does the real work in their hearts! It may trouble us to not see men saved, but we must remember that it is our duty to sow and water seed, and God gives the increase.

The facility in Parchman, MS has recently changed to a monthly program, with two days of service. This format opened a new door of opportunity for me at another prison just ten miles up the road. After finishing at Parchman, I can spend an extra day at Tutwiler visiting and witnessing for as much time as I wish. This fills an awkward hole in the schedule, and allows another opportunity to share the gospel with needy hearts!

The new ROA Bibles are here, and I was able to receive my first order. What excitement these Bibles are bringing to the inmates! When they discover that it is a Study Bible, many of them rejoice out loud, and are thankful for help in studying the Scripture. Thank you for giving for these. My goal is to buy 1,000 Bibles for Mississippi prisons, and we are 1/3 of the way there! Praise the Lord for His faithfulness.

In the first of November, we had the opportunity to take a large group into the Central MS facility, which houses 1800 men and 1800 women. There were five services each evening, and visitation on both sides. My wife was thrilled to take ten women into the prison and witness to the ladies, and we were excited to see many of the women saved during visitation and many as well during the services.

Thank you for your faithfulness to the Lord, and to this work. Remember, God takes notice of what you do for Him, and the rewards are out of this world!
