Since our return to the US for our furlough, we have hit the ground running. Many times I feel we are running in circles; then the Lord tenderly shows the direction. We have had 1 church from Georgia and 1 from California take us on. I have been in California during the whole month of June. We have been able to meet so many nice churches. One church in particular is allowing me to stay in a RV during my stay in CA. Therefore, no motel bills. What a blessing.

Anyone who has ever had to stay in a motel for any length of time knows that it can get mighty expensive. I would like to thank the Calvary Baptist Church of American Canyon for allowing me to live in the RV during my stay in CA.

NEEDS:

As we stated in our last letter, we are trying to be able to return to Ghana in October. We need some things to happen for us to be able to return on schedule. Our school reopens in October, and therefore we must go back at this time. We are in need of \$5,000 for our plane tickets, \$5,000 for our container, and \$5,000 for our generator that we can purchase in Ghana. We know that this is a great amount, especially in the times in which we live. I KNOW that the Lord is able to bring it in before October. If you are able to assist us in this matter, it would be a mighty answer to prayer. We have asked so much of many of you and you have always been there for us. We are truly grateful for all you have done for us and for the ministry of Aiyinasi Independent Baptist Church and Academy. Where do we begin? We have been going to churches ever since we returned to the US. I left for California in the first part of June where I stayed until July 4. They are saving a little money to buy things for themselves for when we return to Ghana. Hannah is growing and is still Daddy's little girl. During the time that I was in California, I would call home and she would always want to talk to me. My wife has held things together while juggling between her mother and the children. Many people have been wondering about my mother-in-law. She is already walking with a cane now and then and is actually moving around the apartment with the assistance of her walker. My wife no longer needs to stay there anymore. Praise the Lord!

We are always grateful for the ministry that God has given to us, but we must not forget those that give and pray so that we can have a ministry. Thank you churches for your faithfulness and provisions for us.
